Welcome to Nolla!

How can I get into the Nolla cabin?

You will receive a door code via email before you arrive at the cabin. Push the door firmly closed before entering the code. Enter the code into the smart lock and press the unlock button to open the door. If you enter the wrong code five times, the door will go into lockdown mode for 10 minutes, after which you can re-enter the code. The door locks automatically when you press it properly closed, causing the red indicator light on the smart lock to light up.

How does the stove work?

- 1. Start the stove with opening the stove lid. Press the ignition button (circular, on the right corner) for approximately 3-5 seconds until the ignition indicator light turns on. Allow the device to start for about 2-10 minutes until a red indicator light appears in the top left corner, indicating that the stove surface is heating up.
- 2. Selecting the heating mode: The device will automatically start in cooking mode (keep the lid open). You can adjust the heat level of the burner using the left-side control knob. If you wish to switch the device from cooking mode to heating mode, turn the control knob 2-3 times back and forth between the numbers 1-6. A light will appear in the bottom left corner, indicating that the device is in heating mode. Close the lid. You can adjust the temperature using the control knob.
- 3. To turn off the stove, press the same button used to start the device for 3-5 seconds. The device will turn off, but it may take about 5 minutes.
- 4. If the stove goes into a fault mode and does not work despite following the previous steps, and possibly flashes indicator lights simultaneously, turn off the power from the main switch for 10 seconds while the indicator lights are flashing. The main switch can be found on the left side of the metal box located on the lower shelf of the right-side cabinet (Black on/off button). Turn the main switch back on and restart the stove.
- 5. The stove was originally designed for boat use, and exhaust gas is directed outside. We use only fuel made from renewable raw materials for this stove.

Electricity

There is an electrical outlet in the Nolla Cabin, and power is available for device charging depending on weather conditions. If there is no electricity coming from the outlet, you can perform the following reset procedure. The reset button is in the right-hand cabinet at the bottom, and it is green in color. Press and hold the reset button until you hear a click. After this, the electricity supply should be restored, and the outlet should operate normally.

Keeping the Nolla cabin clean

It is important that you leave the cabin in a clean state for the next visitor. Please sweep the floor, dust the blankets, and make the beds. Also, leave the shelf and stovetop clean by wiping them with damp cleaning cloths. Dispose of trash in the recycling bins and place dirty dishes in the collection box next to the pier. Please do not walk with your shoes on in the Nolla cabin.

Please let us know about any broken, lost, or dirty items. It is very important to us that the cabin stays clean and well maintained. Please do not leave behind anything that you brought with you, and if you notice anything in the cabin or the surrounding nature that does not belong there, please help us and the environment by taking such objects with you. About the Nolla cabin

Nolla's beds can be spread out into one big bed. If you want to spread the bed, proceed as follows: Roll up the carpet. Then, open the bed drawers one by one from the window towards the door, take out the folding mattresses from the drawers, and place the mattress support plates on top of the drawers (two per drawer). You can find the support plates in the drawers. Unroll the bolster pillows and spread them in the middle of the bed on top of the support plates, and place the regular mattresses on top of them. Spread the folding mattresses to both sides of the bed. After use, assemble the bed again.

When it's sunny, the Nolla can become quite hot. To prevent this, you can use a sun curtain which is available in the drawer. If you are sensitive to light, we recommend bringing a sleep mask.

There is a common barbeque area on the island, which includes a gas grill with all the necessary equipment. Open fires are strictly prohibited on the island.

Water

Please note that there is no running water on the island; therefore, please bring your water. We recommend bringing at least 3 liters of water per day per visitor.

Toilet

The island has dry toilets for both men and women. Dry toilets are located near the cabins and are easy to find.

Personnel

On the island, there is no Nolla staff available. For issues between 10 AM and 6 PM, please call our customer service +358 10 384 5000. You can also email us at info@nollacabins.com. Outside these hours, in case of emergencies, you can call our emergency number at +358 50 520 2508.

General

Tvijälp is a public camping area, so please also be attentive to other campers. The island is in many places difficult to traverse, so we do not recommend Tvijälp as a destination for individuals with mobility restrictions. Please also note that smoking is only allowed in the designated area near the barbecue area.

Open fires are strictly prohibited on the island.


Please always act responsibly on the water.

Access to Tvijälp

You can arrive at the island either by your own boat or by shared transportation. If you choose shared transportation, please purchase a boat ticket when making your reservation. Departure times vary depending on the date and the cabin number you've chosen. Between May 8th and May 31st, as well as between August 19th and October 31st, departure times are 4:30 PM or 5:15 PM, depending on the cabin. Between June 1st and August 18th, departure times are either 12:45 PM or 1:30 PM. We operate transportation to the island using a wooden boat from the 1950s, which can transport a maximum of 8 passengers at a time. Please present your booking confirmation to the boat driver when boarding. The departure point for shared transportation is Keilaranta Marina in Keilaniemi, Espoo, located at Kalanokankuja, 02150 Espoo. We recommend arriving at the harbor using public transportation. Keilaniemi Metro Station is approximately a 400-meter walk from the harbor.

You can also arrive at the island by your own boat; in this case, please select a dock for your boat when making your reservation. There are a limited number of boat berths available.

The return trip to the mainland departs from Tvijälpin Island between May 8th and May 31st, as well as between August 19th and October 31st, at either 4:45 PM or 5:30 PM, and between June 1st and August 18th at 1:00 PM or 1:45 PM, depending on your cabin number. Guests must check out of Nolla cabins 30 minutes before the boat departure time, allowing our staff to inspect the cabins for the next visitors. Please remember to arrive at the pier well in advance of the shared transportation departure.



Please note that there are no personnel on the island!

When the boat leaves the dock, it will not come back until
the following day. So please bring enough water and food on
your trip. If you suffer from any health issues, this destination
might not be for you.

Also please remember that Nolla cabins are not hotels but an all-encompassing nature tourism experience. So, make sure you also pack some adventure spirit for your trip!
